### **Church Description**

Boston Chinese Evangelical Church (BCEC) was founded in 1961 with an initial mission to reach Chinese immigrants in the Boston area with the Gospel and love of Jesus Christ. For over six decades, BCEC has expanded to include not only the immigrants but also individuals from all backgrounds. Today, we gather in seven congregations using three languages (English, Cantonese, Mandarin) each Sunday and midweek ministry activities across two campuses in Boston's Chinatown and Newton, all for the purpose of worshipping God, edifying each other, and sharing God's Good News to our communities.

### **The Pastoral Staff**

We have a multi-staff pastoral team led by a Senior Pastor. The Director of Student Ministries at Newton Campus would work under the supervision of the Newton English Pastor, alongside the Newton Campus Cantonese and Mandarin Pastors, and with the entire leadership team.

### **The Position**

Seeking an experienced, qualified minister to serve as the Director of Student Ministries to lead and oversee students from 6<sup>th</sup> grade to 12<sup>th</sup> grade at the Newton Campus. The ideal candidate is an experienced minister of similar evangelical theology, with experience in larger ministries with diverse languages and cultures—especially within an Asian/Chinese American ministry context.

### **Ministry Responsibilities**

1. Provide pastoral leadership and oversight for the Student Ministries on the Newton campus including discipleship, preaching, equipping and outreach
2. Lead a team of volunteers to oversee Friday evening and Sunday morning programming
3. Partner with parents and guardians to nurture faith at home and in everyday life
4. Build relationships and connections with students and teachers from the local schools
5. Assist the English Pastor in leading worship and preaching during Sunday Worship as requested
6. Partner with other pastoral staff for church-wide programs, operations, and coordination, including the Cantonese and Mandarin congregations at the Newton Campus as well as Chinatown English Ministries

### **Ideal Candidate Qualifications**

1. Appropriate Christian character, reputation, and maturity
2. Compatible evangelical theology with BCEC
3. Theological training in seminary or equivalent
4. Strong competencies in leadership, teaching/preaching, and pastoral care
5. Ability and experience in engaging students online

6. Proven experience in youth ministry in Chinese/Asian church contexts (3-5 years)
7. Ability to work within the vision of BCEC and on a team that is multi-staff, multi-lingual, multi-site, and multicultural
8. Fluent in English; conversant in Cantonese and/or Mandarin desirable but not required
